Thank you for meeting with me and sharing in detail your plans for the U.S. Pipeline project which will be staged in Dennison, Ohio near the Dennison Railroad Depot Museum.

After our discussion, I feel confident that the project would not produce any adverse effect to our National Historic Landmark. The identified concern is noise, and here is the rationale on why it should not pose a threat to the well-being of our landmark:

- Dennison is a railroad town used to the noise of trains.
- During our Polar Express train rides, we have over 500 vehicles from 2,000 passengers plus our volunteers parking each day.
- Dennison has past experience with 200 trucks a day coming to the grocery warehouse, located directly across from the Depot.
