On behalf of Panhandle Eastern Pipe Line Company (Panhandle), Air & Water Compliance Group, LLC (AWCG) is requesting a clearance extension for the PEPL Backhaul project in Lenawee County, Michigan. All proposed impacts will be located within previously disturbed areas at an existing valve facility. The proposed project consists of modifications to the existing gate setting which include miscellaneous piping, pressure control devices and valves. All proposed impacts will be located within previously disturbed areas at an existing valve facility.

The proposed construction Area of Potential Effects (APE) is previously disturbed pipeline right-of-way and existing facilities. All work is located within these areas will be restored to preconstruction conditions, thus having minor impacts to the APE. The projects APE would have minor historical significance.

Enclosed please find portions of the USGS Blissfield, MI 7.5 minute series topographic map, indicating the location of the proposed project. The project located in Section 13, (T8S-R5E) in Lenawee County, Michigan.

AWCG is requesting documented consultation in regard to compliance with Section 106, 36 CFR § 800, the implementing regulations for the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA). Because all Project sites are located in previously disturbed areas, the proposed project is not anticipated to affect properties listed or eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places or other sensitive archeological resources. There are no structures located within the Project workspaces and there are no structures nearby that are listed on the National Register of Historic Places. In the unlikely event that any unanticipated discoveries are encountered, all work will stop and your office will be contacted immediately. Panhandle will retain an archeologist to evaluate the discovery and coordinate with your office. Work will not resume until authorized by your office.




On behalf of Panhandle Eastern Pipe Line Company, (Panhandle), Air & Water Compliance Group, LLC (AWCG) is requesting a clearance extension for the PEPL Backhaul project in Allen, Hamilton, Marion, Parke and Vermillion Counties, Indiana. The proposed project consists of modifications to existing select gate settings and compressor stations. Modifications will include the installation of piping, valves, fittings, and other miscellaneous materials to allow for bi-directional flow through the compressor station. These facilities will allow for gas from the east side of the compressor station (previously discharge) to be routed to the suction side of the compressor units and gas discharged from the compressor units to be routed to the west side of compressor station (previously suction). Automatic valves will be installed such that the compressor units can receive gas from the mainline either on the west or east side of the compressor station depending on direction of flow on the mainline. All proposed impacts will be located within previously disturbed areas within station facilities and the pipeline rights-of-way. **Please take note of Zionsville 3 Gate has enlarged temporary workspace to west (100') and north (100') of the existing site not in previous submittal.**

Enclosed please find portion of the USGS Woodburn South, Noblesville, Zionsville, Carmel, Montezuma and Vermillion Counties, IN 7.5 minute series topographic map, indicating the location of the construction locations in Allen, Hamilton, Marion, Parke and Vermillion Counties, Indiana.
