
On February 20, 2015, Rover Pipeline LLC (Rover) submitted applications to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), and the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality seeking authorization to construct, own, and operate the proposed Rover Pipeline Project (Project) that will extend from the vicinity of New Milton, Doddridge County, West Virginia to the vicinity of Howell, Livingston County, Michigan. The Project will have the capacity to transport 3.25 billion cubic feet per day of natural gas and is a producer-driven pipeline project in which Marcellus and Utica producers have made long-term commitments for transportation capacity to move natural gas production to connections with interstate natural gas pipelines and storage facilities, as well as to major gas consuming markets in the Gulf Coast, Midwest and Canadian regions.

This supplement to Rover's application, which has also been filed with FERC, provides the results of additional biological surveys conducted in late 2014 and early 2015, as well as the incorporation of 25 route variations into the proposed route to accommodate landowner requests, reduce or avoid impacts on cultural or biological resources, or resolve constructability concerns; and the relocation of the Consumers Energy Meter Station from milepost (MP) 67.8 to MP 75.0 in Washtenaw County, Michigan. These changes are shown on the attached map.

The enclosed attachments include revisions to Rover's February 2015 application as a result of reroutes and supplemental environmental surveys. These attachments also address MDEQ's March 25, 2015 comments.
